



**Early Partial / Lump Sum Repayment of Grant / Loan under
Financial Assistance Scheme for Post-secondary Students (FASP)**

1. For early partial repayment, the repayment amount shall not be less than an amount determined by the Student Finance Office (“SFO”) (currently set at HK\$5,000.00) or the total of one repayment instalment, whichever is greater.
2. Interest of early repayment is calculated as follows:

3. For request by post, the postmark date on the envelope will be regarded as the date of request. Underpaid mail items will not be accepted. Please ensure your mail items bear sufficient postage before posting. For request by fax or email or via the SFO E-link, the date of the request received by SFO will be regarded as the date of request. Normally you have to settle the early lump sum repayment demand note in full within 14 days from the issue date of the concerned demand note.
4. The early repayment demand note will be posted to your correspondence address. If you would like to confirm receipt of your request, or you do not receive the demand note by post 14 days after your request, please contact our staff at 2150 6065. Otherwise, SFO will assume that the demand note has been received by you.
5. If a loan recipient fails to repay the loan or interest or any part thereof when it becomes due, he/she will be required to repay to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region the overdue amount together with a surcharge of 5% thereof.
6. If the above grant / loan account(s) have been granted approval for deferment of repayment, the period of deferment would be shortened accordingly. You would have to submit a new application if you wish to defer repayment for the remaining instalment(s) of the above grant / loan account(s). All applications for deferment of loan repayment will be considered on individual merits.
7. If the above grant / loan account(s) are currently under application for deferment of repayment, the deferment application would be cancelled.

- (2) All items in this form are mandatory. If the required information is missing without reasons, the request will not be processed.
- (3) You are advised to submit a request for early repayment of loan after careful consideration. If you cancel and make another request for early repayment of loan within the same month, the SFO may consider not accepting the second/ revised application. If you have fully settled the early partial/ lump sum repayment demand note, cancellation request to ask for refund of the sum of early partial/ lump sum repayment will not be accepted.
